

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE FINANCE, DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND OWNERSHIP OF A COCONUT BIODIESEL PRODUCTION FACILITY IN PALMA

TotalEnergies EP Mozambique Area 1, Limitada (TEPMA1) is developing the Mozambique Liquid Natural Gas Project (Mozambique LNG) in Palma District in Cabo Delgado - Northern Mozambique.

As part of its commitment to decarbonization, local content, and socioeconomic development, TEPMA1 is supporting the establishment of a locally produced low-carbon fuel supply chain for Mozambique LNG operations, based on coconut feedstock sourced from local farmers. The initiative includes agricultural research, nursery development, support for 3,000 farmers, and the planting of more than 440,000 coconut seedlings.

The next phase of the initiative is the development of its agro-industrial component. To this end, TEPMA1 invites interested companies, investors, and joint ventures to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) to finance, develop, own, and operate a coconut biodiesel production facility in Palma District. Mozambique LNG is expected to serve as the anchor offtaker through a long-term purchase agreement, providing a strong foundation for the project's commercial viability and long-term sustainability.

Scope of Work Overview

The scope entails the financing, construction, ownership and operation of an integrated coconut biodiesel production facility (Finance-Build-Own-Operate) with a nominal capacity of approximately 5,000 tons per year of B100 biodiesel, together with the associated feedstock collection infrastructure, in Palma and neighboring districts, if necessary.

The overall objective is to produce a locally sourced, low-carbon fuel for supply to Mozambique LNG under a long-term take-or-pay agreement, while strengthening the local coconut value chain and generating employment and income for smallholder farmers in the region.

The main areas of scope for the interested party are:

- Financing, design, construction, ownership and operation of the biodiesel production facility, including vegetable oil extraction and biodiesel refining units;
- Manage the feedstock collection hubs and the aggregator network;
- Procure coconut feedstock from local smallholder farmers under fair and certified conditions;
- Production and delivery of biodiesel meeting purchaser-approved standards;
- Valorization and commercialization of by-products;
- Provide technical assistance to farmers for sustainable joint food and energy production;
- Compliance with all applicable Mozambican legislation and with TotalEnergies HSE, ethics and anti-corruption requirements.

The plant shall be located in a dedicated area in Palma, outside the Mozambique LNG fenced area, on a plot designated for this purpose.

Further details of the opportunity, including technical and commercial information, will be shared with pre-qualified companies during the subsequent tender phases.

Preliminary Submission Requirements:

2. Interested companies shall also submit an Expression of Interest together with the following documentation:
 - Past safety performance;
 - Articles of Association (as published in the local official gazette);
 - Certificate of Commercial Registration issued less than 90 days;
 - Operational License or equivalent document issued by the relevant authorities;
 - Evidence of tax registration and commencement of activity declaration (M/01C e M02);
 - Company profile;
 - Applicable experience and detailed description of similar biofuel projects developed or operated;
 - Portfolio of projects rendered, including capacity, location and role of the candidate;
 - Personnel qualifications and proposed organizational approach;
 - Personnel qualifications

If the Expression of Interest is submitted by a consortium, it shall be accompanied by the joint venture agreement which must define the terms and conditions of the consortium, as well as the period of its duration and the form of participation of the members of the consortium.
